

# General Club Policies/ Rules & Regulations

The following policies have been adopted for the common good of all Members and are extensions of, and consistent with the Club By-Laws. Violations of the Rules and Regulations that follow may result in disciplinary actions under the Club By-Laws. Members must inform their invited guests of the following rules as they will be held responsible for any violations committed by their guests.

## GENERAL

### 1. Club Facilities

The golf course facilities, including the clubhouse, grounds, lakes and ponds are for the exclusive use of Club Members and their guests for *Golf purposes only*.

### 2. General Guest Privileges

Notwithstanding, the rights of Members that are granted in the Club By-Laws to bring or send guests to the Club and other Tournament Players Clubs, the Club reserves the right to limit such guest privileges from time to time in order to provide Members with priority access to the Club facilities. In keeping with the spirit of this rule, the "pooling" of starting times is not allowed. The Club, in its sole discretion has the right to refuse or limit such pooled starting times.

### 3. Attire

Proper attire must be worn at all times everywhere on Club grounds. For men, collared shirts and Bermuda length shorts or "golf" slacks meet requirements (no jeans). For ladies, accepted golfing attire is required. Short shorts, running attire etc. do NOT satisfy this requirement.

Any Member or guest not appropriately attired may be asked to cease use of the facilities (including food and beverage outlets) until properly attired. Members are again reminded that *they are responsible for their guests adherence to this and every Club rule*. Business casual attire is required in the Main Dining Room. Proper golf attire is required in the Great Woods Grille and all other areas of the clubhouse. No jeans allowed.

### 4. Metal Spike Alternatives

All Members and their guests are required to wear metal spike alternatives at all times on the golf course and Practice Facility.

### 5. Prohibited Activities

In order to ensure safety, activities on Club grounds are limited to Golf purposes only. Activities such as fishing, hunting, jogging, bicycle riding, walking, snow sports and other nongolf related activities are strictly prohibited.

### 6. Pets

Pets are not permitted on any Club grounds at any time.

## **7. Lost Articles**

The Club is not responsible for articles left in the Locker Rooms, about the Clubhouse or on Club grounds. A Lost & Found for items recovered within the last sixty days will be maintained in the Golf Shop. Items not claimed after sixty (60) days will be donated to charity.

## **8. Damage to Club Property**

Each Member is held responsible for his/her own actions as they relate to damage of the Club's property or grounds. In the case of a guest, the sponsoring Member will accept full responsibility and damages will be billed directly to that Member.

## **9. Member/Employee Relationship**

Relations between Members and employees shall pertain solely to the use of the Club facilities and the specific duties of the employee. It is Club policy that Members not be addressed by their first name by any employee. All concerns must be directed to Club management.

## **10. Violations**

The Club's policies are intended to ensure enjoyment of the Club by all. Any person failing to adhere to the Club rules may be subject to penalties as provided in the Club By-Laws, Terms and Conditions of Membership and policies including any amendments which may be posted in the Clubhouse from time to time.
